## News from the Preschool Office

### Welcome...

We are so happy to have your little ones be a part of our preschool. If there are a few tears in the beginning, please know that this is normal even for returning students and that our teachers are loving, kind, nurturing, and very patient during this transition time for your children. Usually after the first 2 weeks of school the tears are replaced with smiles and drop off goes much easier. Please remember it is best to make your good-bye quick and cheerful. Often if the good-bye is prolonged it takes your child longer to settle down once you leave.

### Back to School Reminders...

Please note that all children play hard and fast on the playground and we recommend that children wear shoes that will not cause an accident. Flip flops, Crocs and flimsy sandals are a danger.

If you haven't brought a change of clothes for your child, please remember to put a set of clothing (pants, shirt, underpants, socks) in the plastic bag your child's teacher sent home with you at Open House.

Also, remember to check your child's folder each day as this is how you will receive info and notes from the preschool office and your child's teacher.

Tuition payments are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month and can be dropped off in the tuition box located at the top of the stairs on the 1<sup>st</sup> level of the preschool.

### Registration Info...

If the registration packet you submitted for the 2010-2011 school year is missing any information, please make sure you bring it to the preschool office as soon as possible so we can update your child's file.

### Lunch Bunch...

Lunch bunch will start in October. It will be the first Thursday and Friday of each month. The cost is \$5.00. There will be a sign-up sheet outside your child's classroom. The \$5.00 charge will be added to your tuition invoice for the following month's tuition.
